Until the USGA and GAM can figure how to adjust the handicap with the slope and course ratings for players who want to go to the forward tee's---We will all play from the WHITE TEES. I will make adjustments to tee boxes as we go through various courses. The CLUB will play from tee boxes that range from 5900 to 6400 yards.

SUPER SENIOR DIVISION: This is primarily for the club championships and to qualify a member must be 69 or old the playing year.

Wagering:

We will have the standard \$10.00 weekly wagering which will be broken down in the following

- 1. \$1.00 from each member into a net score pool for the day
- 2. Par 3's closes to the pin are set at \$15.00 per hole
- 3. Balance of the pool goes into NET SKINS

This year will be NET SKINS and NET SKINS ONLY—there will be no bump or trump on natural birdie or natural eagle bumps or trumps net birdie or eagle. THIS IS A NET GAME so therefor it is a push. (This was an agreement by majority of club members present at the 4/19 meeting).
