#### **Medal Club Championship:**

This is a gross score event only

Open to all qualified members of RIGC. Members in this group would be required to play from the back tee positions such that the course will be greater than 6400 yds on each round. Winner will be representing RIGC at the GAM Tournament of Senior Club Champions in late September at Jackson Country Club.

Members in this group are qualified to win the NET Club Championship

#### **Net Club Championship:**

Open to all qualified members including Super Senior competitors.

#### **Super Senior Club Champion:**

Participants in the Super Senior event are not eligible to win the Medal Play Championship. Competitors will play from the middle tees not to exceed 6100 yds.
