MATCH PLAY NEWS

Our 2014 President's Medallion Match Play will start on Wednesday June 4th. The first round is at Boulder Pointe following the second round on June 11th at Cherry Creek. On the evening of June 1-HHS WYNN MILLER will be setting the brackets with Rod Cooper looking over his shoulder. ON June 2nd, I will post the brackets. We were going to have this broadcasted on ESPN but our President Moore could not negotiate contract. Maybe next year. Wynn will be using handicaps posted on June 1. Any dispute you can take it up with him.

We have 32 members that will be participating in this our 5th match play championship. We have lost one of our past winners, Chuck Senkyr, due to severe back problems. We will miss that competitive spirit of yours CHUCK. If you wish to come by around the time we are finishing, please do so---the soda is on the club.

WAGERING DURING MATCHPLAY

• We will not be offering the wagering pool for the first round of match play. This includes the three putt donations. HOWEVER, if we have 16 or more players who want to get into the wagering pool, then it will be open to those who wish to participate. Remember, if you do participate in the wagering pool, then you must complete the hole and complete all putts. In match play, you can forfeit a hole and move on if need be. This wagering policy will hold throughout match play for all those that are left in matchs.

Medal Play Scores during Match Play

• Generally, match play is scored as winning the hole or not. Match Play is a part of our clubs Major Tournaments. There are extra points awarded toward "THE JUG" for Match Play. We do need to have a medal play score for the day. The score can be your gross score and it will be handicapped down to get the low net of the day and so forth. If you do not finish a hole just leave it blank and by USGA we know what to put into that box.

Posting Match Play Scores

• Here is the other reason we need medal play scores. According to GAM, HHS Miller is to post all match play scores and those scores are to be medal play scores. Let's make certain that we have those scores set. The scorecards will be marked for all competition.

If it sounds a bit confusing, it isn't. The best I can tell you is—just play golf, mark your scores and between Wynn Miller, Bill Siegert and myself, we can figure it out. Good Luck.
