There has been some discussions on the second round and the mandatory play. With further discussions, we will have the second round scheduled as it but if you cannot make it, then it will be up to you and your opponent to come up with a date prior to the third round to be completed. WAGERING DURING FIRST ROUND OF MATCHPLAY

After going over the wagering system, WE ARE NOT going to have a wagering pool at the opening round. It is better for all match play players to concentrate on how they are going to be playing the hole against their competitor---that includes the closes to the pin and NO three putt revenue sharing.

HOWEVER

If there are a number of member that get forfeited on their match, then I will put them together in their own little group and you can wager amongst yourselves.

The wagering pool will be back up and running on the following week and during the other match play competitions. It is only match play players that do not have to participate ---until they are eliminated.

Medal Play Scores during Match Play

• Generally, match play is scored as winning the hole or not. Match Play is a part of our clubs Major Tournaments. There are extra points awarded toward "THE JUG" for Match Play. We do need to have a medal play score for the day. The score can be your gross score and it will be handicapped down to get the low net of the day and so forth. If you do not finish a hole just leave it blank and by USGA/GAM we know what to put into that box.

Posting Match Play Scores

• Here is the other reason we need medal play scores. According to GAM, HHS Miller is to post all match play scores and those scores are to be medal play scores. Let's make certain that we have those scores set. The scorecards will be marked for all competition.

If it sounds a bit confusing, it is not. The best I can tell you is—just play golf mark your scores and between Wynn Miller, Bill Siegert, and me, we can figure it out. Good Luck.
